Victor Chandler discussed teacher salaries and changing the methods used for salary negotiations.

Sarah Fortney, a science teacher at Stambaugh Middle School, commented on the importance of relationships and added that employees deserve and expect respect.

Cassie Gibson, a teacher at Haines City High School, commented on the important duty the School Board Members have and encouraged them to commit to the negotiation process on March 10th. She also asked the School Board Members to place salary provisions at the beginning of the budgetary process.

Larry Milhorn, the President of the Association of Federal, State, County, and Municipal Employees (AFSCME), commented on the financial hardships being experienced by employees. He also encouraged the School Board Members to consider the staff salaries at the beginning of the budgetary process. Mr. Milhorn also reminded everyone of the

upcoming pancake breakfast at Brigham Academy on Saturday, March 4, 2017.

Marianne Capoziello, President of the Polk Education Association (PEA), commented on the lack of certified teachers available to teach students at the Turnaround Option Schools (TOP) that was discussed at the School Board work session. She encouraged the School Board Members to stand behind the teachers at McLaughlin Middle School and keep the school as a part of the Polk County Public School system.

Addison Brown commented the Black History Month Proclamation should have been awarded to a community member instead of a Polk County School District employee. He also asked for an update on the status of the Winter Haven middle schools that are part of the turnaround option program. Mrs. Fields commented the Superintendent will make sure he receives a copy of the work session information.

Bishop William Mincey encouraged the public and the School District to come together. He commented that legislators need to be made aware of what is happening to the students of Polk County and how the financial cuts are affecting them. He discussed disrespectful comments that were made about the Superintendent during a recent School Board meeting and encouraged the Board Members to stand behind her.

Mrs. Fields extended a public apology to Mrs. Byrd for not responding to the derogatory comments that were directed at the Superintendent by one of the public speakers at the recent School Board Meeting. She had not comprehended the comments until after hearing the tape for clarification.
