Mr. Wilson commented on the rollback in the Required Local Effort (RLE) millage rate and the impact this will have on our current needs. Mike Perrone, Chief Financial Officer, explained that the millage rate for the 2014-2015 school year was 7.208 mills. The millage rate for the 2015-2016 school year is 7.149 mills which is a reduction of 0.059 mills. This is being brought forward to comply with the Florida Finance Program's regulation to advertise and state the rollback rate as part of the Florida Truth in Millage (TRIM) Act. Mr. Harris shared that the reduction in the millage rate will also result in a reduction in property taxes.

### Minutes:

Superintendent LeRoy reminded the community that the second Parent University will take place on Saturday, September 12, at Lake Region High School. Concurrent sessions will be presented in English and Spanish. Also, transportation and child care will be provided. Additional details can be found on the <a href="http://www.polk-fl.net">http://www.polk-fl.net</a> website.

Another topic the Superintendent addressed was the School Accountability information released by the State. The test results reflect that the test is considered valid, however, school districts across the state are concerned as to how this will affect school grades since learning gains will not be considered in the calculation. Without learning gains, many students will be negatively impacted because they are not yet grade level proficient, and therefore will not get credit for all of their hard work. This will also impact schools, teachers, and leadership that have worked very hard. Scores are expected in the next two weeks from the State, but school grades will not be released until January.

The next work session will be Tuesday, September 22, 2015, at 9:00 AM in the Superintendent's Large Conference Room followed by the School Board Meeting at 5:00 PM in the auditorium located at 1915 South Floral Avenue, Bartow, Florida.
