Thanked the Polk County Legislative Delegation for meeting with Dr. McKinzie and staff regarding the 2007-08 statewide budget reductions. We always appreciate the opportunity to discuss issues in our district; particularly the impact that the 4% reductions would have on Polk County schools. We trust that the suggestions presented which would lessen the impact to our schools will be seriously considered and shared with other Florida House and Senate Colleagues.

Congratulated Dr. Eileen Holden on her inauguration as Polk Community College's 4th President. Our All American Polk County will truly benefit from her enthusiastic leadership style and her commitment to provide a college education for all students who have a desire to do so. Over \$200,000 was raised as part of the inaugural celebration which together with a matching grant will total over \$400,000. This money will be used in part to award scholarships to our graduating high school students enabling them to pursue a higher education. What a wonderful gift to our Polk County community.

Platform. A proposed draft will be presented by the Legislative Liaisons at the October 8th meeting and the platform will be finalized in November.

Two letters are proposed for our Legislators and local government officials: (1) a pre-session letter in the form of questions and answers with detail information on how we use our property tax funds.

(2) an after special session letter reminding the Legislators they are holding the school districts harmless in whatever happens in the property tax reform and; if there is a significant reduction in property taxes, they are to identify another source of revenue for school districts.
