## 36. Superintendent's Report

#### Minutes:

The next work session will be held at 8:30 AM on Tuesday, October 14, 2014 in the Superintendent's Conference Room followed by the School Board Meeting at 1:30 PM held in the auditorium located at 1915 S. Floral Avenue, Bartow.

Superintendent LeRoy reported that the district has been awarded several wonderful

#### grants:

- \$1,500,000 for the next three years from the Department of Education (in partnership with Hillsborough County and USF) to support increasing teacher content knowledge, provide equipment and materials for labs across the district, provide math teachers the opportunity to receive secondary math certification, and provide summer learning institutes.
- \$5,350,000 over the next five years to support mental health services by transforming the climate within schools to support emotional and behavioral services for students. Partnering with DOE, USF, and Peace River Center.
