Minutes:

He discussed the contract dispute regarding the credit recovery services offered by Atlantic Education Partners, Inc. and Acceleration Academies, LLC. Despite efforts to resolve the dispute amicably, further legal action is inevitable. He requested a closed door

attorney/client session to discuss this matter at the Work Session scheduled for December 13. The content will be confined to settlement negotiations and strategies related to litigation expenditures and the entire session will be recorded by a court reporter.
