Mr. Townsend explained why he thought that Superintendents trip was an issue. He doesn't know what her intent was but he wanted to clarify. He mentioned Kate Wallace, who worked for Jeb Bush. He stated that she is a lobbyist and influences public opinion. Mr. Townsend presented a video of Ms. Wallace speaking against public schools. Mr. Townsend is concerned about the time Ms. Wallace spent with Mrs. Byrd during this meeting.

Mr. Wilson stated that Superintendent provided a report once she arrived from this trip. He has attended this meeting in the past and stated that they are using Choice. Mr. Wilson does believe in Choice. He feels that it is important to attend and keep communication open and he supports Superintendent Byrd's attendance of the meeting so she has a sense what to expect in the future.

Mrs. Reynolds stated that she doesn't know anyone who cares about the humanity of our students more that Superintendent Byrd. Superintendent Byrd stopped twice during their conversation to greet two students she knew their names, from different schools. Ms. Reynolds feels that Superintendent made a correct decision to go and greatly appreciates it because now she knows what's coming.
